

CONTEXWeb Implementation Training

The CONTEXWeb implementation training course is designed to occupy two days. This course offers trainees an in-depth look at the implementation of the CONTEXWeb system.

General Training Information

Suggested Training Environment

This course can be offered either at the customer site or at the Compunetix training facility in Monroeville, PA.

Training Prerequisite

Generally, people attending the CONTEXWeb implementation class should possess the following skills:

- Should be computer literate.
- Should be familiar with both DOS and Windows.
- Should possess a working knowledge of Apache/IIS and Tomcat configuration.
- Should possess a working knowledge of servlets.
- Should possess a technical knowledge of HTML/Javascript.

Course Start and End Time

Typically the training course starts at 9:00am and finishes at 5:00pm.

Minimum and Maximum Number of Trainees

The minimum number of trainees per course is two (2) and the maximum is five (5).

Typical Course Agenda

Day 1

During the first day trainees are introduced to Compunetix and the installed system and are given the basic terminology for the course. They also learn how to identify the components of the system and identify their function within the application as a whole. Trainees learn about the function of the Access Server as well as the Application Program Interface (API) used for CONTEXWeb. They are shown the CONTEXWeb turnkey application and are shown how Compunetix used Tomcat to serve the applets. During this day trainees are shown how to verify users using our Access database or using another existing database. Additionally, trainees are shown the Administration application for CONTEXWeb. Topics for day one include:

Day 2

During the second day trainees are given a template overview and are shown how to customize CONTEXWeb and create their own “skin”. Additionally, how HTML and Javascript are used in the application is reviewed. Trainees are also shown how to look at the logs and diagnose common problems. Topics for day two include:

- Customization
- Skin Development
- Troubleshooting

Practical Exercises

Throughout the training course trainees are given practical exercises to apply information learned. Review questions may also be distributed.
